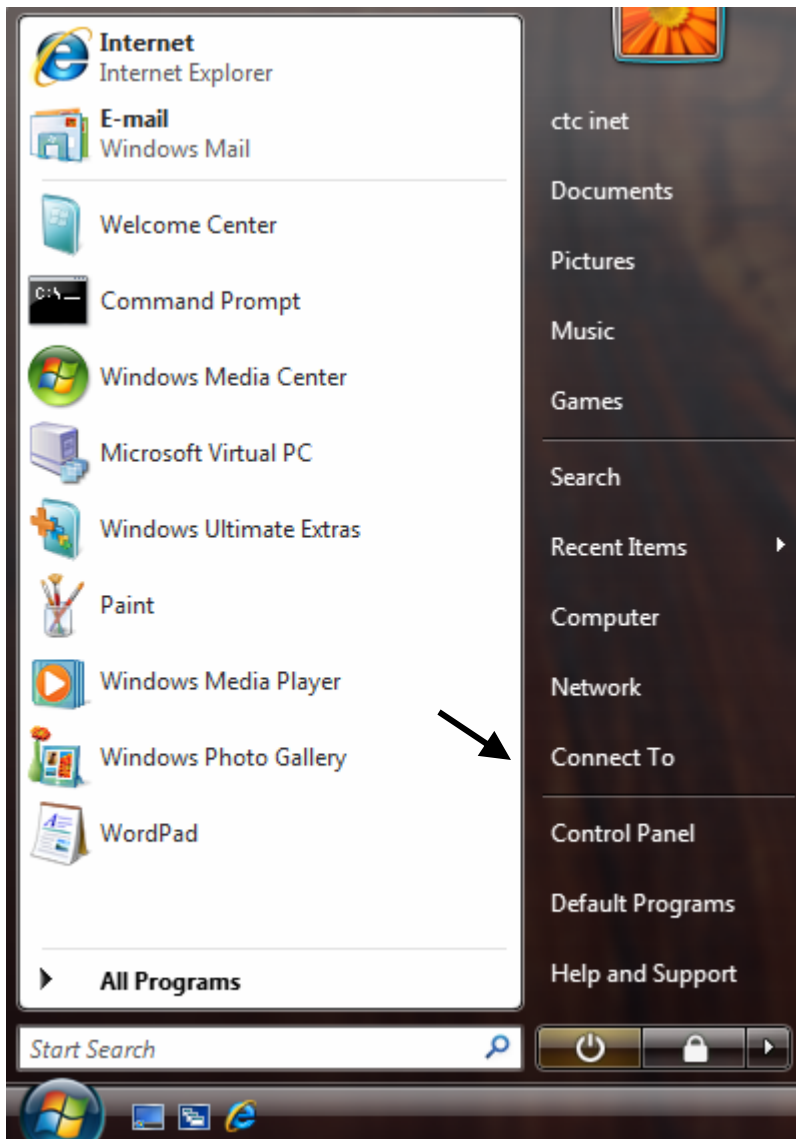
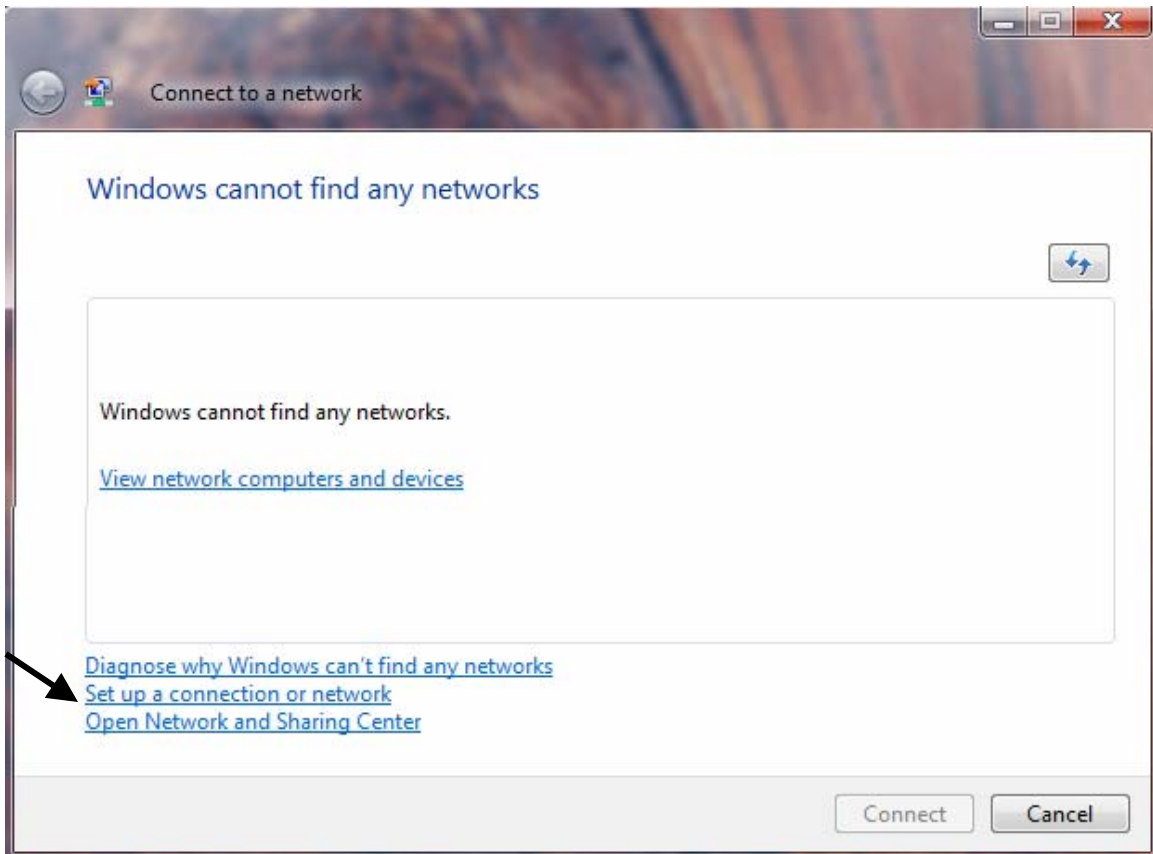


## Dial-up Connection Instructions for Windows Vista

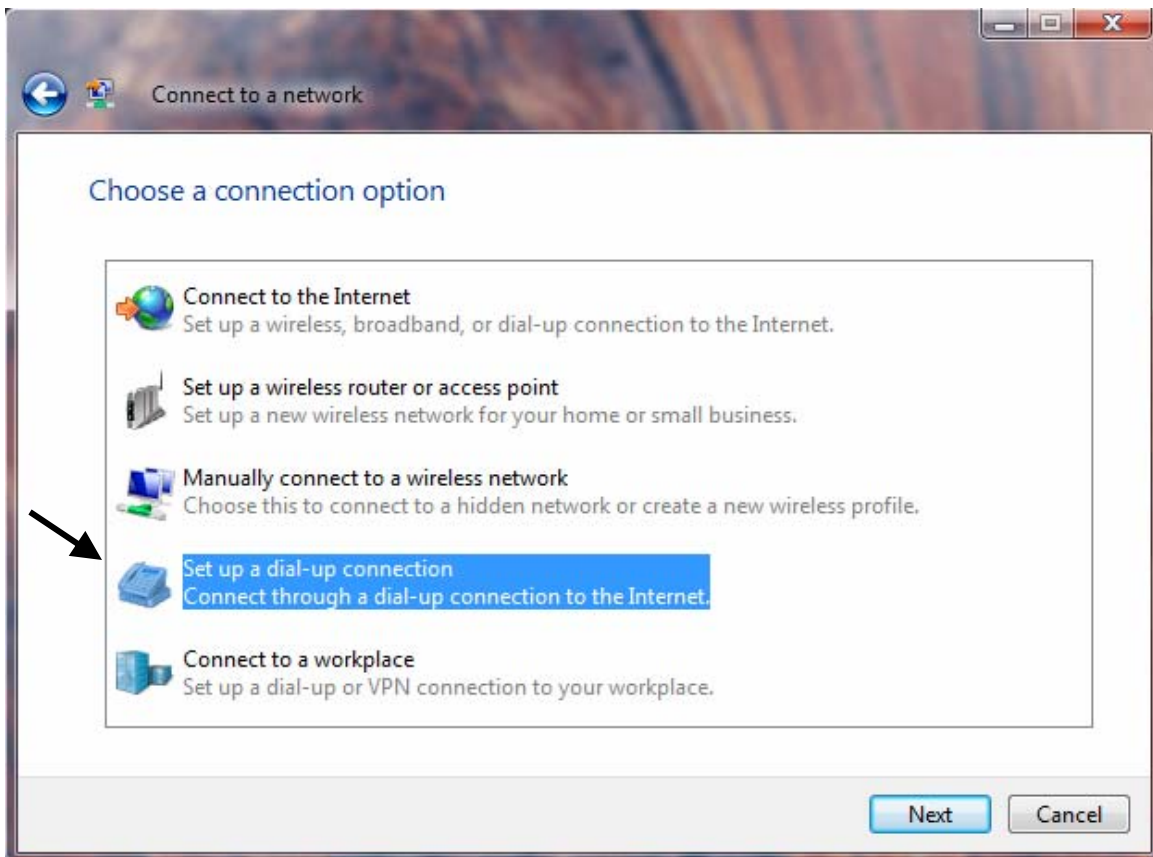
1. From the **Start** menu, click on **Connect To**.



2. Click on **Set up a connection or network**.



3. Click **Set up a dial-up connection**.



4. Click **Next**. Enter the required information for the connection:  
**Dial-up phone number:** XXX-4090  
**User Name:** (the CTC username that was assigned to you)  
**Password:** (the password chosen by you when you registered)  
**Remember this password:**(check this box)  
**Connection Name:** Dial-up Connection (can be renamed)  
**Allow other people to see this connection:** Check this if you want this connection for all users on your computer (recommended)

Note: if you have Call Waiting, temporarily disable it for the duration of your CTC connection by using **\*70,XXX-4090** as the phone number.

Set up a dial-up connection

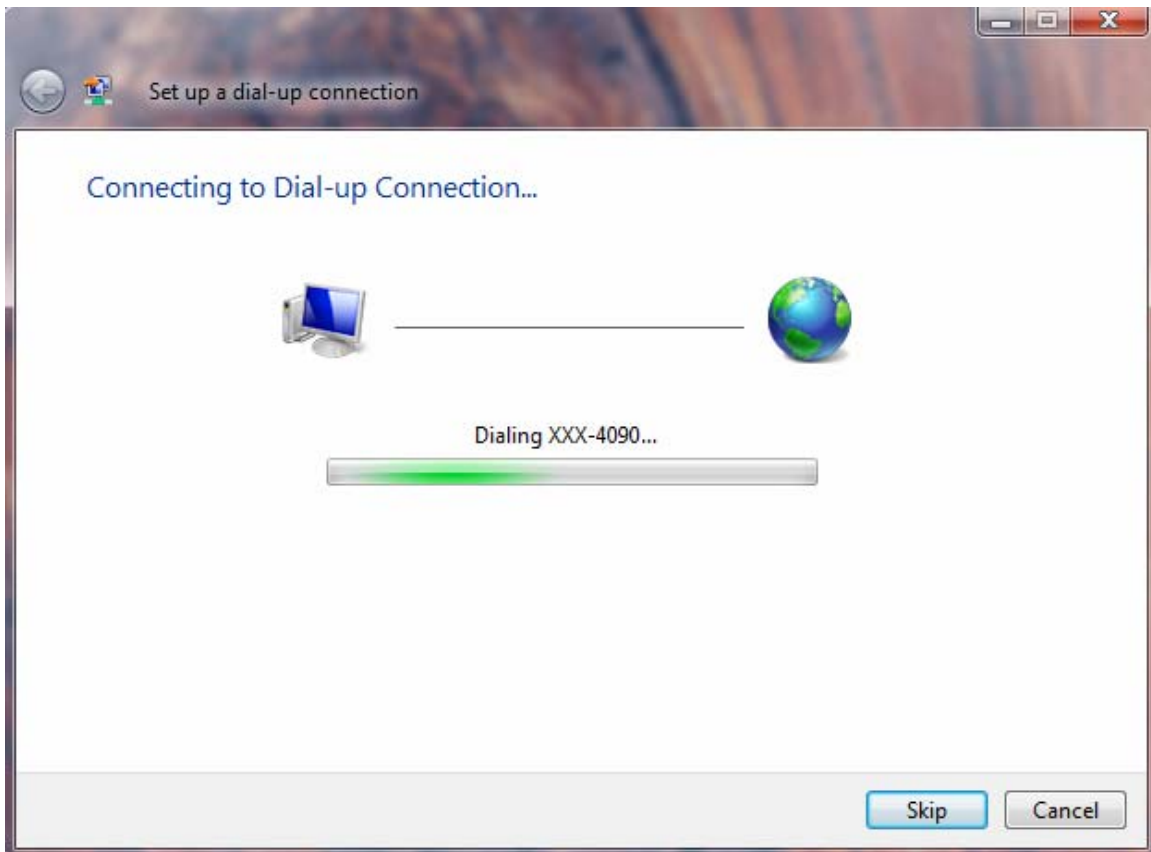

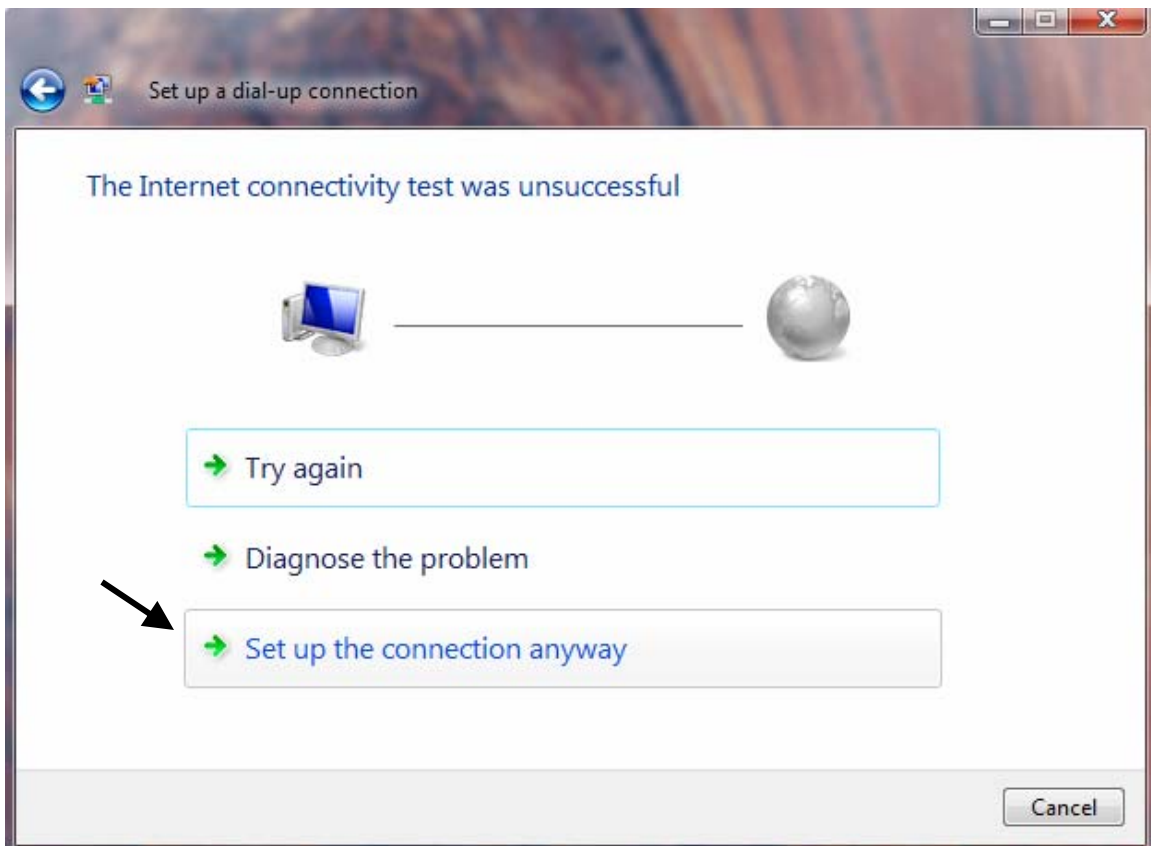

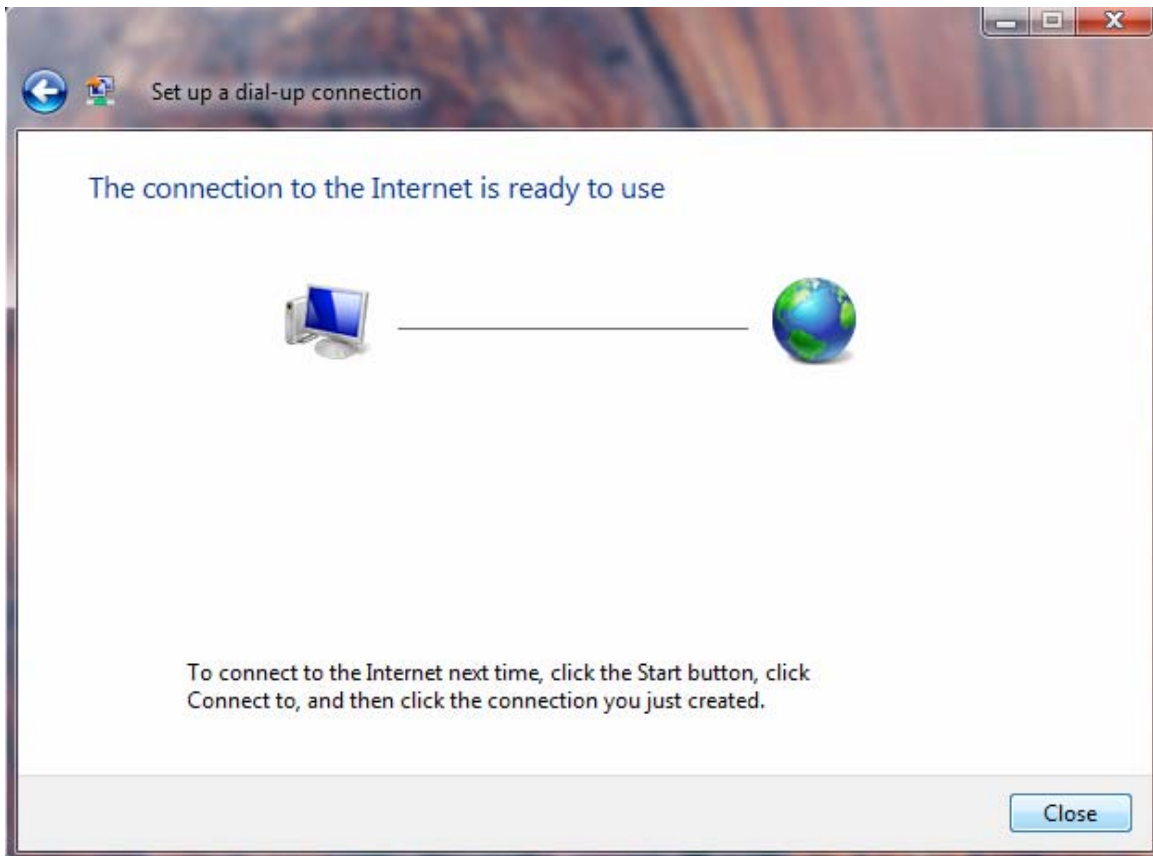
5. Click **Connect** to create and save this connection.
